- Several residents have reached out to us with concerns over the land within the Uplawmoor Woods at the East (Neilston Side) Side of the village. The land owner had recently visited the village and spoken to some residents about turning the area into a caravan site or a paint ball ground.
- Concerns arose as the land owner has an asbestos removal company and has historically dumped rubble & unknown substances into the old mines situated in the woods. Residents have reported seeing gasses rising from the ground in the middle of winter.
- The residents that spoke to us are calling for an investigation into what is in the mines and if the area causes any danger to health.
